



Associate Pastor

Working Relationships:

The Associate Pastor is a part of the pastoral team and the church staff team, and reports to the Senior Pastor. The Associate Pastor will be accountable to the Elder Board and the congregation. Quarterly reports will be given to the congregation.

Profile:

The Associate Pastor is recognized as an undershepherd of Christ's in the local church and an overseer and shall preach the Word of God when called upon, administer the Ordinances of the New Testament, shepherd the church, and lead it in the fulfillment of its sacred task. He shall be an ex-officio member of all boards and commissions and counselor of all departments. He endeavor to maintain a godly deportment at all times, so that no reproach may come through him upon the body of Christ. By the nature of his position, he automatically serves as an Elder but not subject to election.

Responsibilities and Essential Duties:

- Serve as lead over the middle school and high school ministries
- Collaborate with Director of Christian Education on materials and ministry directed at youth and families
- Lead and administrate elementary and youth aged outreach ministries
- Teach in Sunday School program
- Lead/teach/participate in mid-week small group events
- Participate in worship planning for Sunday services when necessary
- Participate in regular meetings of necessary boards and commissions
- Preach and teach intermittently for entire congregation
- Lead/teach/participate in Sunday night service
- Participate in the daily administration of the church
- Other duties and responsibilities as mutually agreed upon by the pastoral team
- Other duties and responsibilities as assigned by the Elder Board

Qualifications:

- Meet the Biblical qualifications as stated in I Timothy 3:1-7, and Titus 1:5-9
- Must be in hearty agreement with the church's Constitution and Statement of Faith and willing and able to stand for and defend the Statement of Faith
- Commitment to a historical-critical hermeneutic
- Able to communicate testimony to both believers and unbelievers
- Experience speaking to groups of various sizes
- Competency with various types of technology and applications
- Willingness to humbly learn and engage tasks
- Bachelor's Degree preferred
